Citizens Health implements changes to visitation

Citizens Health is working closely with local, state and federal health officials to control spread and provide needed care during the COVID-19 pandemic. We have done so while continuing to safely meet the primary specialty and emergency healthcare needs of our patients and their families. Our top priority is keeping our patients, visitors and staff safe.

We have made some changes to our visitation policy.

VISITATION CHANGES

Effective Tuesday, June 2 at 6:00 a.m.

Visitors are limited to 1 person per day on Monday –Friday 6:30 AM - 7:00 PM and Saturday and Sunday 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Hospital Visitors

Patient and visitors must use the front entrance. Temperature screenings will continue upon entry to our facilities. When you enter the hospital, you will be directed to a screening station where someone will take your temperature and ask a series of screening questions. Visitors with a temperature will not be allowed in the facility.

Valet parking has closed. If you need assistance into our buildings between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:30 pm we would be happy to meet you with a wheelchair at your vehicle and assist you to and from your appointment. Please park in the parking lot and call (785) 462-7511 and someone will assist you.

Unless you have a scheduled pediatric appointment, visitors 14 years of age and younger will not be allowed in the hospital until further notice.

Clinic Visitors

One (1) support person is allowed, however visitors with a temperature will not be allowed. The visitor cannot be a child age 14 years and younger

The FCHC waiting room continues to be closed. The patient and visitor should wait in their car until the nurse is ready to take them to a room.

Prairie Senior Visitors

The Prairie Senior administrative team is anxious to allow any type of visitation for their residents. However, at this time the state and federal regulations do not allow any lifting of visitor restrictions in the long term setting.

Mask Recommendation

Citizens Health continues to highly recommend all patients and visitors wear masks while in our facility. If you do not have your own, one will be provided for you.
